This matter having been brought before the Court on the application of Obermayer, Rebmann, Maxwell & Hippel, LLP, attorneys for plaintiffs RPA Associates, Inc. and Mosher & Doran, Inc. t/a RPA/Mosher & Doran (collectively, "Plaintiffs"), pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 65, for entry of a preliminary injunction against defendants The Mosher Group, Inc., Frederick K. Mosher, Frederick K. Mosher, Inc., Robert C. Davis, Frank S. Radosin, Gerald K. Van Pelt, Jr., Ronald M. Siegler and Jane F. Francz (collectively, "The

Mosher Defendants”), and the Court having considered the papers submitted both in support of and opposition to said application, as well as the arguments of counsel for the respective parties; *and having considered the Plaintiff's objection to the form of this order,*


IT IS on this 22^d day of July, 2003;

ORDERED that Plaintiffs’ motion for entry of a preliminary injunction against The Mosher Defendants shall be and hereby is denied in its entirety; and it is,

FURTHER ORDERED that during the pendency of this litigation or until further notice of this Court, The Mosher Defendants shall maintain all business documents, including bank account statements and documents relating to accounts receivables and accounts payables, in a manner consistent with the ordinary course of business; and it is,

FURTHER ORDERED that The Mosher Defendants shall produce all business documents, including bank account statements and documents relating to accounts receivables and accounts payables, maintained in the ordinary course of business in response to proper requests for same during discovery in this matter; and it is,

FURTHER ORDERED that during the pendency of this litigation or until further notice of this Court, The Mosher Defendants shall not make any transfer, liquidation or expenditure of business assets of TMG Engineering, Inc. outside the ordinary course of business.
